Make an information page about a lighthouse. Where is it? How old is it? What is it used for? Is it still being used?	Go for a walk around your local area. Find and draw light sources that you see.	Draw/paint day time and night time pictures. Talk about the differences.
Watch a firework display. Write a firework poem about the sounds and colours.	Turn off the lights in one room. Talk about how it feels to be in the dark. Imagine and write about what it would be like if we did not have lights in our homes.	Make a famous London landmark using a range of materials. Use some ideas from our geography lessons about London.
