Create a spider diagram of all the different words for hot and cold.	Make a picture using hot colours (red, orange, yellow) or cold colours ( blue, grey, white, silver)	Go to the local library and research information about the Great Fire of London. Create a poster with your findings.	Make a fact file about a hot or cold country. Try and use an atlas and include the different animals that live there.
Find out about how things change when they are heated or cooled e.g. ice, chocolate, metal.	Write a poem about fire or ice.	Free choice  Do you have your own great ideas to do with fire and ice?	Research Samuel Pepys. Make a historical diary page. (Use a tea bag, to make the paper look very old)
