Find out about how the sun and moon are connected to religions.	Make a quiz about our topic for children to answer.	Create a model rocket.	Research Copernicus or Galileo.
Research a female astronaut.	Make a timeline of space exploration in the twentieth century.	Design a Muslim prayer mat and draw a prayer Jewish artefact. Explain how they help followers to pray.	Read different books about space from across the genres (e.g. fiction and non-fiction)
