Dear Parents and Carers,

Our topic this term will still be **The Olympians**. We are continuing to consolidate and extend key skills in English, Mathematics and Science. It would be great if you could support your child by listening to them read every day and test them on their number bonds and times tables. Boosters will also be continuing this half term: Maths booster is on a Tuesday and Literacy booster on a Wednesday.

<b>Literacy</b>	Non-fiction: balanced arguments and suspense story
<b>Speaking and listening</b>	Hot seating, role play and discussion
<b>Numeracy</b>	Measures/shape, fractions/decimals/percentages, solving problems
<b>Science</b>	Sound and the Human Body
<b>Computing</b>	Coding and Programming
<b>Topic: Olympians</b>	We will be focusing on the history of the Olympics in Ancient Greece and modern day Olympics.
<b>PE and Sport</b>	Athletics and Swimming
<b>Music</b>	Singing and composing songs (taught by a specialist teacher) Strings- Violins and Cellos
<b>PSHE</b>	Relationships – children to understand the purpose of friendship and why it is important.
