Our topic this term will be '**Thrill-Seekers**'. We will be consolidating and extending key skills in English, Mathematics and Science, revising key concepts. Reminder

PE days Y6 will be doing PE on Mondays. PE kits must be worn. It is essential that your child brings in a change of clothes and trainers. On Tuesdays both classes will be going swimming. We will be walking both to and from the swimming baths so please ensure your child is wearing appropriate footwear and coat.
