

SUN SAFETY

	You should apply sun screen cream to your child before they come to school in the morning.
Please send your child to school with a clear, labelled bottle of cold water every day , (if you put it in the freezer overnight it will stay cold all day). NO JUICE, FIZZY or POWER DRINKS PLEASE	
	
Please do not let your child wear flip flops or shoes without heel-straps to school.	Make sure your child wears sensible flat strapped sandals. (This MUST be black or White)
Encourage your child to wear a cap outside . This helps to keep the sun off their head or face and stops them getting overheated.	
	Your child can wear the green and white checked dress or white polo shirts and black trousers or shorts . Please make sure all clothing has your child's name on it as at this time of year it often gets lost!
Scooters and Bicycles are not allowed in the playground. Children must come off their scooters and bicycles before they enter the school grounds.	

Safeguarding

At Osmani, we are committed to ensuring your child is safe both in and out of school. If we have any concerns about your child, we will talk to parents and carers and find out if there is any further support needed for you and your child. Occasionally, a child will make a disclosure in school which will need to be reported to Social Care for further advice. They will then advise us of the action that needs to be taken.
