Introduction

Nursery place allocation in Tower Hamlets has changed recently due to an increase in birth rate.

This leaflet explains how this may affect your application to an Osmani Nursery class.

Why should I send my child to Nursery?

Attending our Nursery class will be a valuable introduction for your child to school life. The Nursery class at Osmani has a very similar structure to the



Reception classes and so will help develop your child's skills ready for them to attend Reception.

A place at Osmani Nursery does not guarantee a place in one of our Reception classes. You will have to complete a separate application form for a place in Reception. There will be an information session about this during the Nursery year.

How is a decision made about application to Nursery classes?

Where there is insufficient Nursery places, priority in the 2015/16 school year will be given by the Headteacher in the following order:

1. Children who are or have been looked after by the local authority within one year prior to the admission date (children in public care).
2. Where there are exceptional social/educational/medical needs for the school applied to. You will be asked to provide a report from a professional to support the application e.g. from a doctor or social worker.
3. Children with brothers or sisters in the school at the time of admission.
4. Children living in the designated priority areas for Stepney schools. Within this category, priority will be given to pupils who live nearest the school, as measured by the shortest walking distance to the nearest available pupil entrance in constant use.
5. To those living nearest the school.





With the recent changes to Nursery places in the borough, Osmani has 52 full-time places available.

Full-time 8:55am until 3:10pm

All Nursery places are offered without charge.

What if my child is not offered a place at Osmani?

If you have applied for a place at Osmani Nursery, but have not been offered a place, you can ask for your child to be placed on the school's waiting list. Your child will be ranked using the admissions criteria as shown overleaf. A place will then be offered when it arises.

What happens if I don't get offered a Nursery place at any of the places I have applied to?
