Maths

Our maths focus this week will be Addition. This skill can be incorporated into many activities.

Key vocabulary - add, bigger, more, altogether



Monday - We are adding groups of objects this week. have bowls with a different number of objects in each. Encourage your child to add the first bowl then the second. Ask them how many there are altogether. Encourage your child to add another different amount each time. (have no more than 8 objects in each bowl)

Tuesday - Explain to the children that we are continuing to add two groups of the objects together. Recap what happens when you add 2 amounts. Give your child pens and paper. Play <https://uk.splashlearn.com/addition-games> (add with pictures up to ten) encourage your child to write the answer.

Wednesday -play this addition game with your child.

Thursday - Explain to your child that we are still working on addition. Recap by showing a line of two different types of fruits (or two different types of objects will be sufficient). Tell your child to tell you how many of a certain fruit there are. Encourage them to write the number. ask your child to count the number of the other fruit and write the number. Ask them to add both the numbers together. Do a few more together with a different number of fruits each time.

Literacy

Our **learning intention will be to talk about our favourite moments in Nursery.**

LS: My favourite moment was when... I enjoyed... I liked... because...

Monday - Have a conversation with your children about the things they like to do in school. Ask them what they like the most. Encourage them to give as much detail as they can, and ask questions to extend the interactions. Make a list of all the things they say that they enjoy.

Tuesday - Friday - Choose one of the things from the list you made for your child to draw. Remind them of what they said - I liked or I enjoyed. Then encourage them to draw a picture of it, talking about their drawing as they make it. Once they are finished, encourage them to practise writing their name on their picture to show that it is their work. To extend your child, see if they can use their knowledge of phonics sounds to label the drawing.



Topic



Creative - can you create a superhero HQ for your supertato to plan his adventures? Use junk modelling to create a place for your superhero to be based. Use boxes, bottles, paper, card and tape and get creative!

Write "L" for land animals and "S" for sea animals.

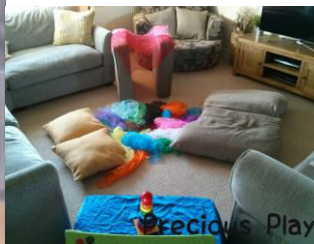


Understanding the World - Think about different places that animals can live. MAKE a list of animals that live on land and in the sea/water. Then, make two posters to show animals that live in each habitat.
