<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● We will be continuing to support children to develop their social skills such as sharing, being good friends, being kind and gentle with each other and resolving conflicts amongst themselves. We will do this through 'Our Rights' and the use of 'TAG'. ● We will be encouraging children to think about what it means to have a growth mindset and therefore supporting their independence and resilience as learners.
<p>Physical Development</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The children will continue exploring the environment and developing their confidence in moving in a variety of ways. We will be focusing on our throwing, catching and aiming skills. ● We will continue to support children in developing independence with all their toileting, dressing and feeding needs while at school. ● We will encourage the children to be confident to independently express their needs to staff. ● We will continue to develop the children's fine motor skills and control through aiming activities, mark-making, cutting, and sorting activities.
<p>Communication and Language</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● We will be encouraging the children to speak in full sentences and listen to each other and the adults in nursery. ● We will be giving children lots of opportunities for role play and storytelling. ● We will collect and learn new and interesting words to develop our vocabulary. ● We will be listening to sounds, songs, rhymes and stories and joining in with them!



<p style="text-align: center;">Literacy</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will continue encouraging mark making, writing and reading by providing a range of writing materials and books throughout the nursery setting. • We continue to work on writing our names and extending their writing into simple words and captions. This will be supported by our daily Read Write Inc. lessons in which the children are learning Set 1 letters and sounds and how to read simple words.
<p style="text-align: center;">Mathematics</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Money, money, money!</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will be working on reciting numbers to 20 and consolidating our number and shape recognition skills. • We will continue to work on number formation. • We will encourage children to use everyday language related to money, capacity and distance.
<p style="text-align: center;">Understanding the World</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will be exploring floating and sinking and thinking about different types of transport. • We will continue to celebrate the children as individuals through circle times and helping them to talk confidently and positively about themselves. • We will continue to introduce the children to the range of technology and technological toys in the nursery, particularly through role play activities, and helping them to develop their skills and understanding of how to use and care for it.
<p style="text-align: center;">Expressive Arts and Design</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will be encouraging children to express themselves in a variety of ways, including through dance, paint, modelling, drawing, singing and playing musical instruments. • The children will be encouraged to engage in imaginative role play in various areas of the nursery. • We will be encouraging the children to create their own props using objects and resources in the learning environment.
