We are extremely excited to have ALL the children(Nursery-Year 6) back in school this week.



The children have settled in really well and are very, very happy to be back in school.

We continue to focus on ensuring the children's safety and wellbeing as well as a return to our school curriculum.

However, we **MUST** all work together to ensure the health and safety of children, staff and parents.

To support the school, we ask for your patience and understanding as we work to ensure that all of our protective measures are working well.

The start of the school day with the 'flexible drop off' is working really well. So, **THANK YOU!**

WE STILL NEED THE FOLLOWING SUPPORT FROM ALL PARENTS:

BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL DAY

- Drop off your child/ren between 8.30am and 8.48am. **The gates close at 8.50am**
- Avoid congregating in front of the school gates. Leave as soon as your child/ren has gone through the red gates.*(Our neighbours and other pedestrians have lodged a complaint about parents congregating in front of the gate)*

AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL DAY:

- Arrive exactly at the designated collection time for your child/ren. Do **NOT** arrive earlier or later.
- Follow the instructions of members of staff at the gate.
- Follow the one way system.
- Be patient whilst staff call your child/ren.
- Leave the premises as soon as you have collected your child/ren.

ONLY NURSERY/RECEPTION PARENTS DROPPING OFF AND COLLECTING THEIR CHILD WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PLAYGROUND

Finally, we ask you to please **RESPECT** school staff. We are continually striving to ensure that the end of the day collection goes even smoother.

HIERARCHY OF PROTECTIVE MEASURES



AVOID MAKING CONTACT WITH ANYONE WITH SYMPTOMS

1. a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
2. a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
3. a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Most people with coronavirus have at least 1 of these symptoms. **PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD/REN TO SCHOOL, IF THEY OR ANYONE IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD HAVE AT LEAST ONE OF THESE SYMPTOMS.**

COATS AND JACKETS

Please send your child to school with a jacket or coat that has a **hood**. Having a coat with a hood will help on rainy days.

WATER BOTTLE



In order to avoid spreading germs through the water fountains, we ask that your child bring in their own see-through water bottle each day. Please **write your child's name clearly** on the water bottle.

If your child leaves their water bottle in the lunch hall, please pick it up in the box by the tree in the playground when you collect them at the end of the school day.
