Key priorities/ Issues	Possible Actions
Reduce our over-reliance on cars, buses and trains	<p>Promote walk-to-school/cycle-to-school activities through role-play assemblies etc</p> <p>Take part in clean air/ clean environment campaigns</p> <p>Run in school competitions to promote the use of bikes, scooters, and walking</p> <p>Lead assembly on the impact of our carbon footprint.</p>

Safety awareness- Gangs and knife crime	<p>Invite visitors (police officers/ Princes Trust Ambassadors) to talk to children about gangs and knife crime</p> <p>Hold workshops to teach children the signs of gang grooming and how to keep themselves safe.</p> <p>Create posters to promote the need for safe streets around our schools</p> <p>Invite visitors to speak to children about theft and the law</p>
Health and Well-being including mental health	
Mental health awareness	<p>Promote the need for more exercise and catering to your mental health.</p> <p>Campaign for movement breaks in lessons to help with focus</p> <p>Hold healthy eating/ healthy living competitions- exercise fun day etc.</p> <p>Hold more lessons and workshops on health and mental well-being</p> <p>Campaign for well-being days in school where children spend a day taking part in a range of physical and mental health activities</p>
